TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. TO DRIVE FORWARD THE DECOLONISE KEELE PROJECT AT EACH DISCIPLINE LEVEL
2. ANALYSE THE CURRENT STRUCTURE AND CONTENT OF YOUR PROGRAMMES AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGE, I.E. HOW TO DECOLONISE YOUR PROGRAMMES. SPECIFICALLY TO GATHER EVIDENCE, IDEAS AND SUGGESTIONS AROUND THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:
 - A. IN WHAT WAYS DOES THE STRUCTURE/CONTENT OF YOUR PROGRAMME(S)/COURSE(S) REFLECT COLONIAL/ IMPERIALIST/EUROCENTRIC BIAS?
 - B. WHAT ARE THE KEY TEXTS/AUTHORS THAT HAVE BEEN WRITTEN OUT OF YOUR DISCIPLINE/PROGRAMME(S)/COURSE(S)?
 - C. WHAT WOULD A DECOLONISED MODULE/COURSE LOOK LIKE IN YOUR DISCIPLINE?
3. TO REPORT PROGRESS TO THE DECOLONISE KEELE NETWORK STEERING GROUP.
4. TO PRESENT/SHOWCASE YOUR PROGRESS AND IDEAS TO THE DECOLONISE KEELE NETWORK PROGRAMME OF WORKSHOPS AND/OR FUTURE TEACH-INS
